TITLE: GRAFFITI WALL

A small to large group art activity

Introduction: This activity invites the participants to create their vision for a more just world. The participants will define justice and create an illustration for what justice would mean for themselves, their church, and world. During this activity, the participants are also invited to listen to one or both of the videos below in the materials section while they create. Afterwards, they are invited to share what they have created.

Online or In-Person: Both

Goal(s): The goal of this activity is to all students to creatively imagine what a more just world could be.
