TITLE: HISTORY MATTERS

A small to large group trivia game

Introduction: This jeopardy like activity uses trivia questions to create a conversation about representation. The questions are broken down into racial history and culture categories. Due to the way that American history is taught in school, the participants will likely know the answers to the White History Questions but will likely not know the answers for the other races/ethnicities.

Online or In-Person: Both

Goal(s): The goal of this activity is to stir conversations around justice through representation:

Materials:

- Internet Access
- A computer or tablet
- A projector or screen if done in person

Expectations:

- One group will respond at a time
- Use of search engines to find answers is reliant up the leader

Leader Notes: This game will work easier if you have the participants in predetermined groups. It is up to the leader to decide whether to allow the participants to use the internet to look up answers. This is also a great activity to talk about what "winning" in a game like this looks like. Take the time after this activity to discuss why these other histories are not represented even though they are taking place at the same time and in the same county as the White American facts.
